



CITY OF HILLSBORO ANNUAL FALL CLEAN-UP DAY THURSDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2020

The City of Hillsboro in cooperation with CWI (Republic Services) Disposal Service is sponsoring a special clean-up day **Thursday, October 22**, to assist residents in discarding certain items. Only **residents** of the City of Hillsboro, who are billed for water/sewer/trash service, may participate in this City-sponsored program. The service is provided at **NO CHARGE**.

When is the Pick Up Scheduled?

CWI Disposal Services will begin pick up at **6:00 a.m., Thursday, October 22**. You must have your items out by this time. Please do not set out items prior to Wednesday, October 21. Trucks will be by each residential stop only once. There will be no callbacks!

What Items are Included?

Household waste, appliances (freon unit must be removed from freezers/refrigerators and tagged by a qualified technician prior to pick up), bulk items, television sets, bikes, swing sets, furniture, home remodeling debris (i.e., drywall paneling, carpeting, flooring material, roofing, shelving, windows, doors, etc.). Glass (window panes, storm doors, etc) must be broken up and placed in a taped box marked "glass." Wood boards must have the nails removed. Metal drums must have the tops and bottoms cut out.

CWI requests that all discarded items be stacked neatly for collection. Be sure that all materials/items are placed where your normal trash is set out for pick up.

Items That Will NOT Be Collected?

Prohibited items include: brick, concrete, dirt, stone, railroad ties longer than four (4) feet, hazardous or chemical wastes, commercial and/or industrial waste, motor oil, automotive batteries and items that will not fit in the body of a truck are prohibited and will not be picked up. **ABSOLUTELY NO TIRES OR CAR PARTS WILL BE COLLECTED!**
