City Response to COVID-19 Recommendations

Today, in accordance with recommendations from the Jefferson County Health Department, the City of Hillsboro will be closing all public facilities following the close of business Tuesday, March 17th, 2020, until further notice. These facilities include; Lobby spaces at Hillsboro City Hall and Police Department. We are taking these precautions to minimize social contact among the general public and city staff to ensure the continued delivery of service (Parks, Police, Sewer, Streets, Trash, Water, etc.) to residents.

We encourage the use of our drop box located at the front of City Hall for Utility payments. We invited citizens to call the City with any concerns or questions at (636) 797-3334. City staff will continue to report to work as scheduled.

As of March 16th, the City of Hillsboro will suspend municipal water service disconnects until further notice. Any delinquent account will still accrue any late fees, charges, and interest. It's vital as a community that we take care of ourselves, each other, and any that may be affected by this pandemic. As this pandemic continues to evolve, we hope everyone stays healthy and safe.
