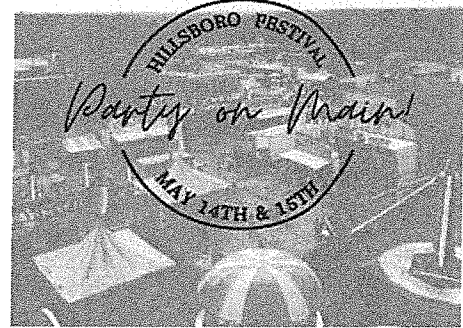

Dear Parade Participant:

The parade will be Saturday, May 15th at 11:00 a.m. Parade lineup will begin at 10:00 am behind the Hillsboro Intermediate School located on Business 21. Please check in when you arrive to receive direction on where your place in line is located. There will be volunteers stationed beginning at 9:45am at the 3 entrances.

The route of the parade will go from the Hillsboro Intermediate South onto 21 to Main Street and will end behind the courthouse parking area. Awards will be announced immediately following the end of the parade on the main stage located on Main Street.

Trophies will be awarded to the "Best of" in each designated category. Additionally a Grand Prize of \$100.00 will be awarded to the "Best of Parade." *Winners will be announced on the main stage around 12pm.*

Important Notes:

- **Adult Chaperones for groups with children.**
- **Please ensure children are not dangling their legs from a float or vehicle.**
- **There is a lot of traffic as the parade line up is happening. Please make sure kids are not running around or in and out of vehicles.**
- **Keep legs away from wheel wells or the hitch of the trailer.**
- **No jumping or getting on or off floats as they are moving.**
- **Candy or giveaways should be tossed under hand or handed out. No throwing candy directly at the crowd items should be tossed near the feet not at the head.**
- **Please make sure to clean up any mess or trash while you are decorating or getting your float ready.**

Please create a sign and place the number on your float on the passenger side as this is what the judges will be using to clearly identify entries.
