

The City of Hillsboro, Missouri, seeks applications from qualified applicants for a full-time Public Works position. The successful applicant must perform any combination of the following duties using various tools, machines, and equipment. Public Works employees perform routine maintenance on City facilities, vehicles, and equipment. Maintain and repair streets and sidewalks to include installation of street signs and striping. Repair and replace water and sewer lines. Install and read water meters. Perform basic arithmetic computations, read blueprints and shop drawings. Operate trucks of various sizes (pickup, dump, snowplow equipped) asphalt roller, tractor, skid steer, and backhoe. Basic carpentry, plumbing, electrical, and automotive maintenance skills are desirable. Communicate orally and in writing with customers, suppliers, City and contract personnel, and the general public. The individual must demonstrate tact, initiative, and sound judgment. Individuals must possess a valid Missouri driver's license and have a high school diploma or GED with a minimum of three years related experience or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience sufficient to perform the job's essential duties successfully.

Individuals selected must be willing to work an emergency on-demand over time. Must be willing to work out of doors in all weather conditions with exposure to traffic and potentially hazardous situations. Must be able to lift and move materials and equipment weighing up to 75 pounds. Must have good hearing and vision, including color vision. Must be able to climb, bend, stoop, crawl, and work in various difficult positions. Must be willing to take a medical examination to include drug testing.
